

## **HARVEY BURROWS TROPHY Secondary School Section, North Bay Curlers Cup, Annual Competition**

This Harvey Burrows trophy pre-dates the North Bay Granite Club which was constructed in 1950. This trophy was presented annually to the Secondary School Section Champion. By good fortune, the Harvey Burrows Trophy now calls the Granite Club's Norm Morin Trophy Case home. First presented in 1947-48 the trophy was won by H. Allen, P Jensen, R. Burns and Skip B. Smith. Of interest, in 1948-49 the winning team members from the North Bay Collegiate Institute and Vocational School were C.Straiton, E.Brownlee, D.Sullivan and was skipped by none other than Harvey's son Jack the future Mayor of the City of North Bay.

About the sponsor of the HARVEY BURROWS TROPHY:

Burrows Country Store and Garden Centre has operated in North Bay since 1915. The original Burrows Country Store was started by Harvey Burrows in 1915 at the corner of Cassells and Percy in North Bay's downtown. Harvey Burrows was born in North Bay and the original store sold groceries and eventually added livestock feed, agricultural products and was a distributor for Purity Flour Mills. Harvey sponsored a curling trophy for the Secondary School Section. Harvey retired in 1958 and handed the reins over to his son Jack. Jack Burrows moved the business to its current location at Third and Cassells. Today, it is predominantly a garden center.
